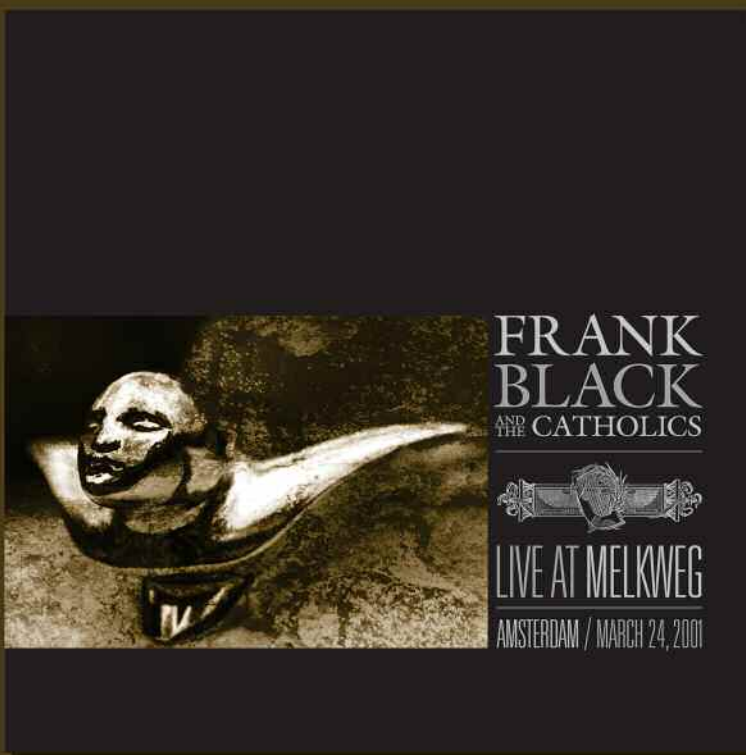

In their usual high-energy fashion, Black and the band unapologetically rip through their expansive catalog, banging out with uncanny familiarity some of Black's greatest Pixies' tunes like "Mr. Grieves", "Monkey Gone to Heaven" and "Where is My Mind?" Frank Black & the Catholics "Live At Melkweg" was recorded in the aftermath of Dog in the Sand, which "plays as a true classicist rock 'n' roll album, without resorting to clichés or sounding reactionary." Reminiscent of "Exile on Main Street-era Stones and early Bowie . . . all the tracks share a rootsy feel, accented by Rich Gilbert's frequent use of a pedal steel guitar." The Catholics represent "rock as large, expansive, and over-romanticized . . . as the western skies hanging over the rural-route honky-tonk dives whose atmosphere they so readily evoke."

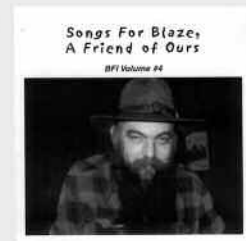

Charles Thompson has been making music professionally since the late 80s as the leader of **The Pixies**, as **Black Francis** or as **Frank Black**. We are pleased to offer **Frank Black & The Catholics** -- *Live At Milkweg* recorded in Amsterdam during March of 2001. This is a precursor to a six CD box set definitive overview of the band available later this year.

Blaze Foley was a Texas renegade outlaw singer-songwriter of whom legends have been invented. **Townes Van Zandt** said "He's only gone crazy once. Decided to stay." His songs were recorded by **Merle Haggard** and **Willie Nelson**, **Lucinda Williams**, **Gurf Morlix** and the aforementioned **Townes**. He was murdered in 1989. His casket was wrapped in duct tape. We have four albums of **Blaze** covers and tribute songs by these and other artists. Gone but definitely not forgotten.

Very pleased to have a VERY limited edition 12" Vinyl four song EP from **Kurt Wagner** of **Lambchop** with **The Altered Statesman** which includes two early versions of songs on the brand new **Lambchop** album released in February.

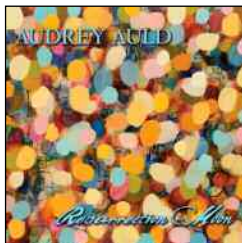

Audrey Auld, *Resurrection Moon*

Resurrection Moon is a 20-track overview of the veteran singer-songwriter's best-loved songs of the last decade. It's been 15 years since Auld issued her debut EP — and 14 since the launch of her own Reckless label. In that time, the native Tasmanian has released 5 internationally acclaimed solo albums of original songs, a live record, an acoustic collection of traditional Australian folk songs, and a duets album with Bill Chambers. But she's never stopped to catch her breath long enough to assemble a proper compilation of her own best work — until now. "These previously released tracks are the songs I continue to sing live," says Auld from her home in East Nashville. "The songs may not be 'hits,' but they strike a chord which resonates in the hearts of listeners.

She sings it sweetly, but with a flirty flash of unmistakable, cocky cheek — almost a dare, really, as befits a **fiercely independent artist who's been self-releasing albums for more than a decade now under the tell-all banner of Reckless Records.** Her dozen new songs on *Come Find Me* find her **confidently moving from folk and country to swinging jazz, rock and even an intriguing bit of talking-blues-style rap.**

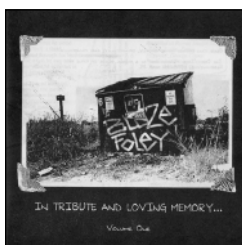

He grew up idolizing Roy Rogers and had opportunities to meet Roy, as well as Gene Autry as a young man, cementing his admiration for both the men and their music. 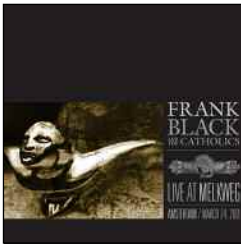

Chief Fuzzer, *Transcendental Road Blues*

Look out rockers! Chief Fuzzer has arrived to shake and thump 2012 and the years to come. This swampy, pedal pushing trio from San Marcos, Texas simultaneously channel ZZ Top, Blue Cheer, the rootsier side of Queens Of The Stone Age and your favorite stoner metal band. Drizzle it with psychedelic psauce, inject a dose of *Disraeli Gears*-era English Blues, turn up the guitar and unleash the bass and drums and you've got their debut EP, *Transcendental Road Blues*, issued as a 7-inch vinyl single with a download card of the full five-song EP included. It's a bracing first blast that previews a full album coming later this year. Deftly balanced on the fulcrum of classic and right on time for today, Chief Fuzzer meld rock from a garage large enough to house a big rig with a potency that plays like it belongs on an arena stage, and have been rapidly gaining a following throughout Central Texas. 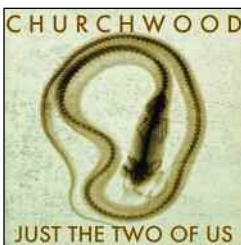

Churchwood, *Just The Two Of Us*

"Dangerous, foreboding, in-your-face," is how Lone Star Music describes Churchwood, whose 2011 debut album won raves for how this Austin-based band "take the essence of primitive blues and mutate it into something new," as the *Santa Fe New Mexican* observes. T. Tex Edwards, *Intoxicated*

T. Tex Edwards "remains a pioneering, under-appreciated, and often neglected chronicler of offbeat and eccentric traditions of country rock'n'roll," notes *All Music Guide*. *Intoxicated* remedies any neglect of this wild and wooly Texas musical treasure with **19 collected odds, sods, unreleased recordings, demos, outtakes and offbeat gems from throughout his distinctively different musical career** spent kicking up some seriously cool and twisted dust from the roots rocking underground. Featuring work under his own name as well as T. Tex outfits as The Loafin' Hyenas, Tex & The Saddle Tramps and The Swingin' Kornflake Killers are such top T. Tex moments as renditions of Psycho and Lee Harvey was A Friend of Mine, his classic Move It (also recorded by The LeRoi Brothers), and Dave Davies' Kinks hit Death of a Clown - and to wrap it all up, a demo of a commercial Tex cut for the Chili's restaurant chain. It's an intoxicating collection from an artist of uncommonly cool off-kilter brilliance.

With their powerhouse debut album, *Hate & Love*, El Pathos may have "nailed their very own Exile on Main St. on the first try," hails Rank N Review. Strong words indeed, and proven true by a listen to what plays like a definitive 2012 rock disc that stands on the shoulders of giants to cast its own long shadow. 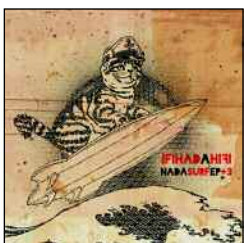

Shrouded Strangers, *Lost Forever*

Formed some time ago in Harrisonburg, Virginia, but persistently sidetracked by other projects after they re-located to Washington DC (first as sociopathic proto-punks and Arena Rock recording artists the **Carlsonics**, and then as incandescent psych-folkies **Nethers**), The Shrouded Strangers continue to be *Lost Forever*. Their third album, recorded in a cabin in the woods of Guerneville, California, finds the boys doing what they do best: sweating around an 8-track machine and dropping white noise atop sputtering Camaro/Casio freak-outs (Featherbed), sea shanties about botched mutinies (Black Tie White Atlas Shrugged), discomfoting childhood hallucinations and fuzzed-out hillbilly stomps. It's a strange, consistently damaged, and very-occasionally beautiful collection of disembodied pop tunes and psych-sing-a-longs in which all the characters involved all seem a bit bewildered. Passing Mt. Satu is the second album from Sweden's Solander, and shows a more focused and determined band whose music is now finally getting widely spread in the US. The playful songwriting results in an album wherein the mood swings from one song to another and keeps the listeners' ear guessing. Everything is tightly bound together by the characteristic voice and guitar picking of Fredrik Karlsson, the innovative playing of cellist Anja Linna and the driven rhythm section handled by Mikael Persson. Solander adds touches of unconventional banjo playing, metallophones, haunting organs, distorted hand-claps, a passionately played piano and lots of other odd sounds spread throughout the album. 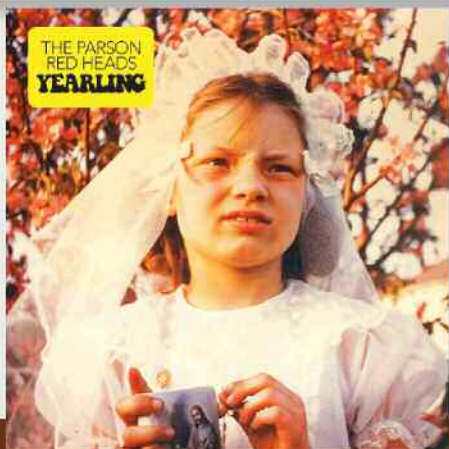
